

## **Senator Richard Colburn Medical Scholar Award Application**

The Colburn Senate Medical scholarship will provide the sum of \$1000 (\$500 if attending a community college) to a graduating high school student from the Maryland 37<sup>th</sup> Senate District.

### Application Criteria:

1. Applicants must be scheduled to graduate at the end of the 2009-2010 school year.
2. Applicants must provide proof of acceptance for admission to a post secondary school in the State of Maryland and demonstrate a major in a medically-related field. (Exceptions to Maryland college/university will be made where no Maryland school provides academic program related to field of study).
3. Applicants must be favorably recommended by their school principal, guidance counselor, or other individual unrelated to them.

Applicants must submit a completed application in typed or legibly written or printed form in a sealed envelope prior to the deadline to be eligible for selection.

2. The essay in Part II
3. The completed Academic form in Part III, along with attached transcripts
4. Letter(s) of recommendation
5. Proof of acceptance for admission
